7.2 Drainage Works and Asphalting of Main Driveway.

At the 5 September 2012 Trust meeting, cemetery staff were authorised to undertake the rectification of drainage works and the asphalting of the driveway based on a preliminary cost estimated prepare by Council's engineering team.

Following this meeting, cemetery staff met with Council's engineering team to advise that the Trust wished to proceed with the above works. At the meeting, Council staff advised that a revised estimate had been prepared based on new calculations and that there was a significant price increase in the costings. After further discussion with the sexton it was also revealed that asphalting may not be the most appropriate surface for longevity. Asphalt requires regular traffic to maintain the integrity of the surface.

Council's engineering team has now fully investigated the work required and sought quotations for the above schedule of works. Attached as confidential Appendix A are their findings.

This information was presented to the Trust for further consideration. Given the significant price differential between the preliminary cost estimate and the quotations received, the Trust has reviewed its position in relation to this matter and modified the scope of works.

7.2 Drainage Works and Asphalting of Main Driveway (cont'd)

- Cemetery staff liaise with Council's Engineering Department to rectify the drainage problem, replace the broken kerb and channel at the head of the circular driveway with rollover kerbing and top-dress the existing driveway with compacted lilydale toppings in lieu of asphalt or concrete.
- 2. Cemetery staff in consultation with the Chairperson are authorised to approve works to a total value of \$60,000.00 (excluding GST).
- 3. If works exceed the value of \$60,000.00 (excluding GST), this matter will be brought back to the Ferntree Gully Cemetery Trust Special Committee for further consideration.

7.3 New Ashes Niche Walls Update

Cemetery staff in conjunction with Council's Engineering Department are in the final stages of preparing specifications and associated documentation for a request for quotation for both the ashes niche walls and ongoing supply and inscription of memorial plaques. Once the documentation is finalised, staff will call for quotations and manage the selection of the preferred supplier in conjunction with the Chairperson as per the Committee's resolution dated 5 September 2012.

Cemetery staff updated the Ferntree Gully Cemetery Trust Special Committee on the status of the progress of the establishment of the ashes niche walls approved at the September 2012 Trust meeting.

8.2 Fee Structure - Application for an Increase Above Consumer Price Index (CPI)

The Department of Health automatically applies an annual CPI increase to all cemetery fees above \$50.00 on 1 July.

Any application for a fee increase above CPI must be received by the Department of Health by 28 February, 2013.

A comparison of Ferntree Gully Cemetery's fees against local cemeteries and similar sized cemeteries shows that overall our fees are averagely priced. A comparison matrix is attached as Appendix C.

The Department of Health has developed a fee application matrix that allocates an industry standard for overheads (10%), general maintenance (5%) and GST where applicable. Confidential Appendix D outlines the justification for a fee increase above CPI for the above fees. Testing a random sample of our existing fees indicates that there is no justification for an increase above CPI at this time. This will be reviewed again prior to the 2014 fee application deadline. A draft fee application form is attached as Appendix D for approval by the Trust.

It has been identified that a number of fees are not cost effective in relation to material and labour costs. It is recommended that the Trust apply for above CPI fee increases for the following fees:

8.2 Fee Structure - Application for an Increase Above CPI (cont'd)

Attached as confidential Appendix D is the proposed fee application, detailing material, labour, overheads, and maintenance costs in support of the application.

It is proposed that the increase for plaques be set to a percentage increase of cost plus 30% rather than an individual sum as any increase from our supplier would then necessitate another fee application to be submitted. The Department of Health advises that the fee application be submitted as presented, to support the increase, however, a covering letter can stipulate that a percentage figure be applied instead of a set dollar amount.

The annual CPI increase will apply to the balance of fees not listed in the over CPI increase application.

NOTE 1 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The significant policies which have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are:

(a) Basis of preparation

This financial report is a general purpose financial report that consists of a Comprehensive Income Statement, Balance Sheet, Statement of Changes in Equity, Cash Flow Statement, and notes accompanying these financial statements. The general purpose financial report complies with Australian Accounting Standards, other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board, the Local Government Act 1989, and the Local Government (Finance and Reporting) Regulations 2004.

The accounts have been prepared on the going concern and accrual basis under the convention of historical cost and except where stated do not take into account current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies adopted for the reporting year are consistent with those of the previous period, unless otherwise stated.

(b) Cash and cash equivalents

For the purposes of the Cash Flow Statement, the Trust considers cash and cash equivalents to include cash on hand and deposits at call.

(c) Basis of accounting

In preparing the financial statements, the Trustees note that the ability of the entity to continue as a going concern in the long term is uncertain due to the lack of sustainable operating profits or cash flows from core business activities, particularly as all available cemetery plots and vaults have been sold.

(d) Comparative figures

Comparative figures, where appropriate, are reclassified to enhance comparability with the figures presented in the current reporting period or to comply with revised or new Australian Accounting Standards.
