

Active Travel Committee

What is it?

An Active Travel Committee:

- Is a representative group, consisting of a combination of staff, parents and students, that focus on increasing active travel or improving road safety within the school community
- Increases the schools capacity to deliver initiatives by sharing the workload amongst different school community members
- Leads the delivery of active travel and road safety initiatives

Setting up an Active Travel Committee

Promote

- Inform the community of its commitment to improving road safety and increasing active travel to school through school assemblies, newsletters, staff and school council meetings.

Recruit

- Request expressions of interests to join the Active Travel Committee.
- Alternatively, you may wish to utilise an existing student leadership group or parent/staff committee.

Initiate

- Set up a meeting(s) and arrange the date, time, location and agenda.
- Ensure all members understand what the responsibilities of the Active Travel Committee are.

Assign

- Assign initiatives/actions and responsibilities to match the skills and capacity of committee members.

Review

- Before the end of the school year, review the committee and recruit new members for the following year if required.
