- Where do I go for.....? As we transition from our working career to the next life stage, there are
 many issues which have not needed to be faced previously and our knowledge of where to get help
 is limited. Some of the issues we face are- personal; as in loss of identity, sense of belonging, sense
 of autonomy. Financial; how do I cope with limited funds/savings. Emotional; loneliness, loss of
 previous social network.
- Am I healthy? We are faced with a lot of information about health and often it can be confusing and contradictory. Attending G.P/specialist/ alternative medicine/etc. is becoming very costly where does our local council sit in amongst all of this? We also need to take a holistic approach and take care of our physical, mental, emotional, psychological, social and spiritual needs.
- Am I happy/satisfied with my life? Often, there is a change in your lifestyle downsizing/tree change/ retirement living/etc and this can mean getting to know new communities which can be challenging. Some people wake in the morning and wonder how they are going to fill in the hours before going to bed at night.
