Conditions:

- All dogs and cats on the property must be registered with the Knox City Council and securely confined to your premises in accordance with the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*.
- If a permit is granted, it will be subject to review following receipt of any complaints from neighbouring properties, and is valid for one year from date of issue.
- Any runs, yards, sheds, pens, kennels, etc. constructed on the property will be subject to the conditions provided in the Administrative Guidelines of Council’s *General Provisions Local Law 2010*.
- Failure to comply with any of the above conditions could result in this permit being cancelled and/or penalties as prescribed in the Local Law.
- A Local Laws Officer will attend and inspect the animals, and housing of the animals to ensure that the animals are kept in accordance with the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1986*, with adequate shelter, food, and water, and secured to the property in a manner to maintain safety of the animals and prevent nuisance to any neighbouring residents.
- Any excess excrement is disposed of in a manner to prevent odour, and in accordance with the *Public Health and Wellbeing Act 2008*.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- As in accordance with Council’s *General Provisions Local Law 2010*, where a permit is issued for more than 2 dogs and/or 2 cats, any additional animals beyond the initial 2 are to be desexed unless otherwise permitted by Council.

DEFINITIONS

- Dog** A dog of either sex or desexed that is over the age of 3 months.
- Cat** A cat of either sex or desexed that is over the age of 3 months.
- Livestock** An animal (including a bird) of any species used in connection with primary production or kept for recreational purposes other than a dog or a cat (includes but is not limited to horses, cattle, sheep, donkeys, mules, goats, pigs and deer of any age)
- Rodent** Includes any rabbits, guinea pigs, mice, rats and hamsters and other mammals characterised by incisors adapted for gnawing and nibbling
- Poultry** Includes chickens (but not roosters), ducks, geese, peacocks, pheasants and turkeys and anything similar of any age.
- Large Bird** Any pigeon, cockatoo or any other bird or similar size or larger size of any age but does not include poultry of any age.
- Small Bird** Any budgerigar, canary, finch or other similar size or smaller bird.
