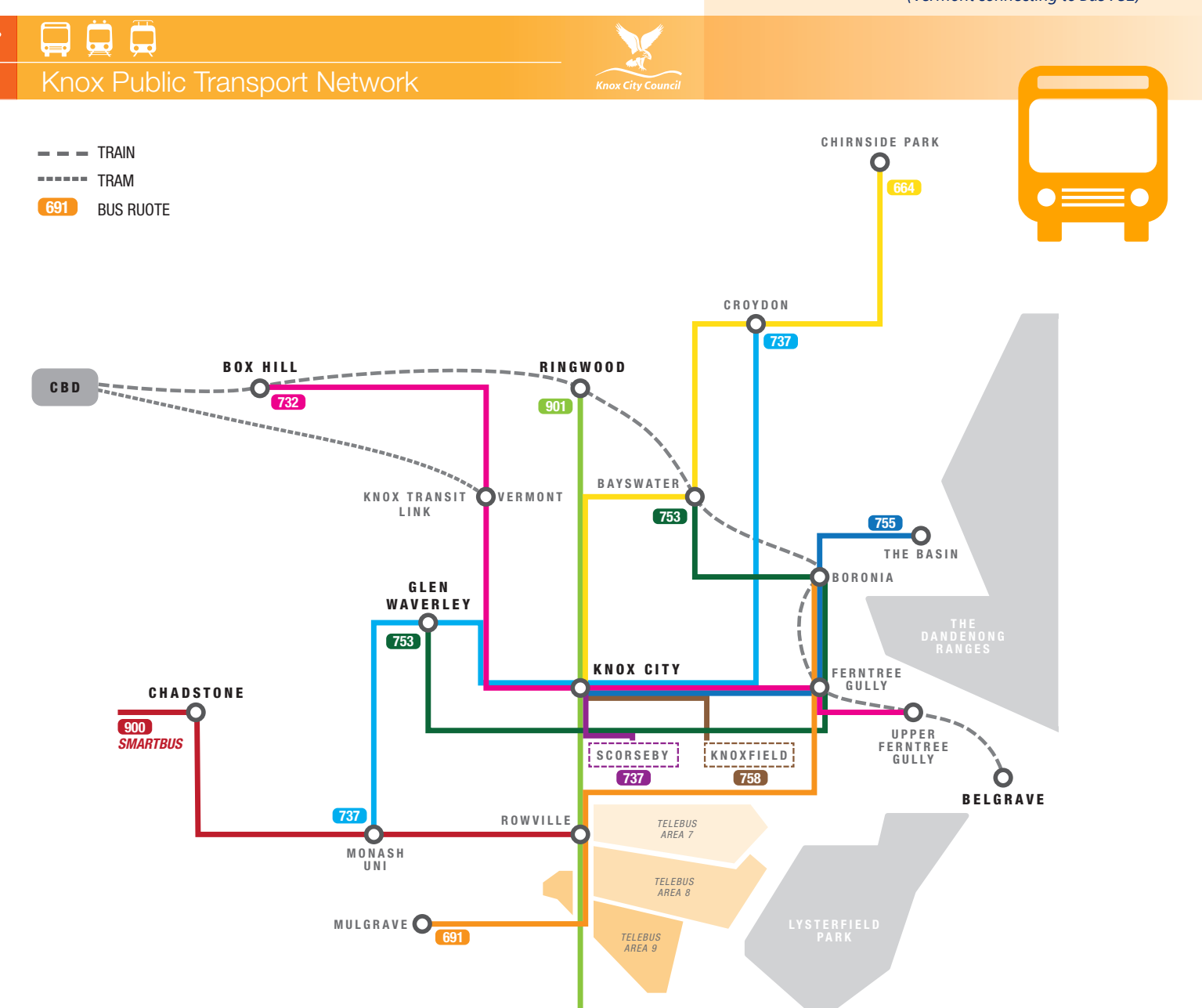
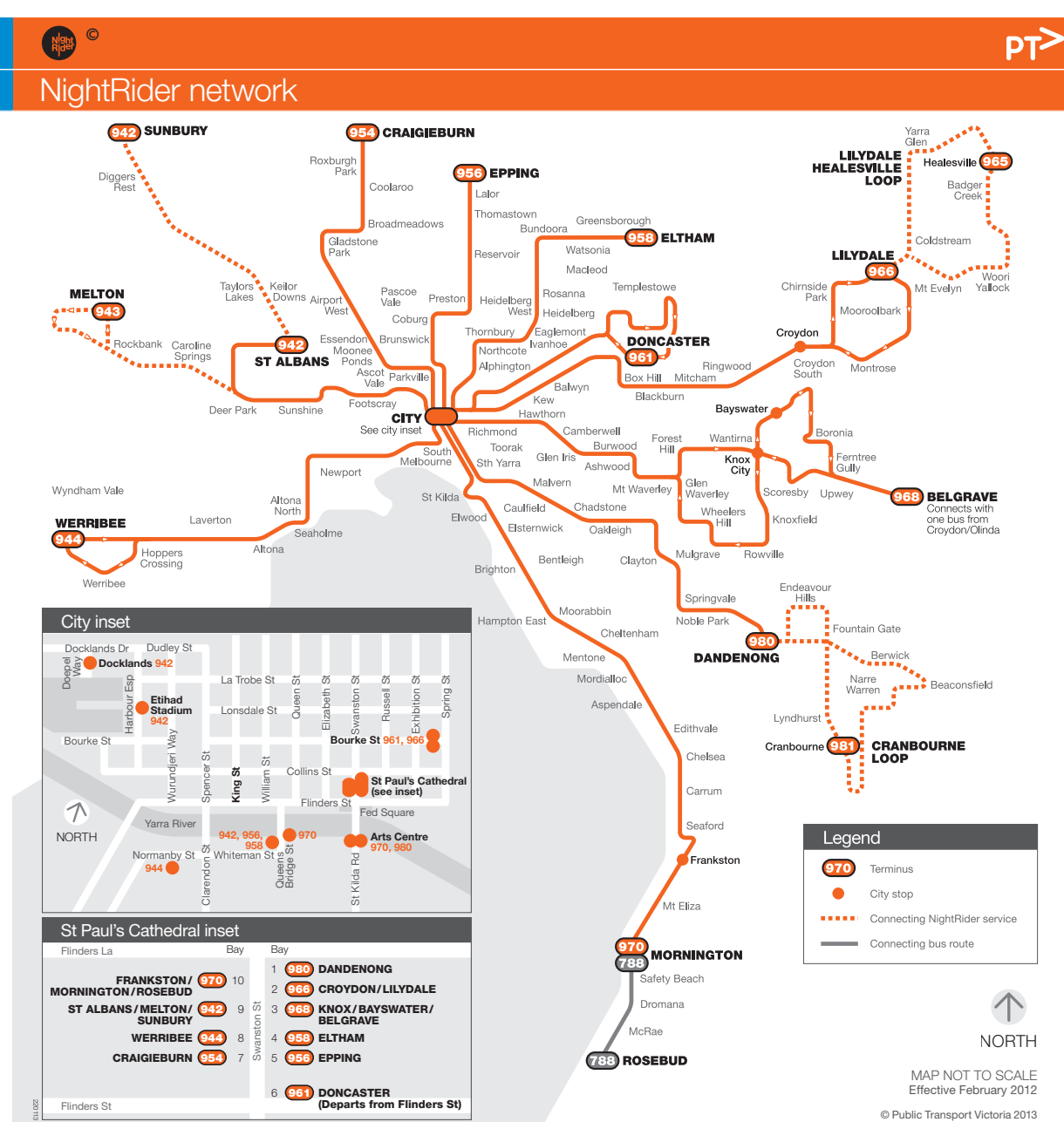
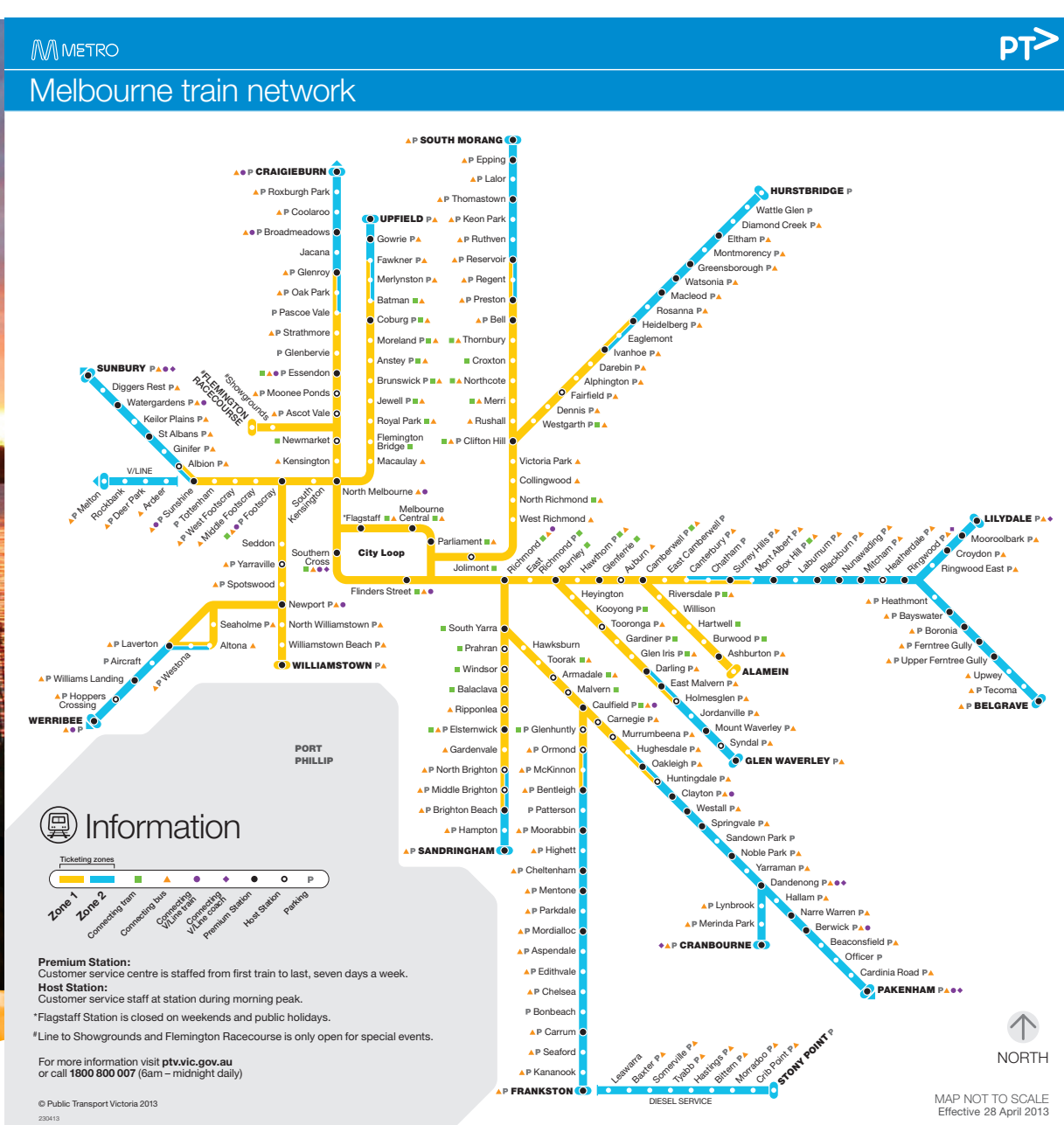

- Not to cross near trees or bushes as drivers may not see you
- Lower your music so oncoming vehicles and cyclists can be heard
- Wear clothes that are bright or can reflect light
- Cross at signalised crossings when available

## HEALTHY BITES

### National physical activity recommendations for 5-18 year olds

- Kids love to be active. Daily physical activity is not only fun, but also healthy
- For 5-18 year olds, at least 60 minutes of moderate to vigorous physical activity everyday is recommended.
- 5-12 year olds should not spend more than two hours a day using electronic media for entertainment (eg. Computer games, TV, internet), particularly during daylight hours

### National physical activity guidelines for adults

- Think of movement as an opportunity, not an inconvenience
- Be active every day in as many ways as you can
- Aim for at least 30 mins of moderately intense physical activity on most, if not all days
- Enjoy some regular, vigorous physical activity for extra health and fitness

## IN TOUCH WITH NATURE

Starlight Reserve in Rowville has been through many changes. This is the site of a former World War I prisoner of war camp, and has now returned to its natural bushland. Visitors can enjoy the wetland and tree-lined bush setting and view interpretive art on national, cultural and historical values of this bushland of Knox.

The Knox Environment Society, located near the Ferntree Gully Library, has been supporting indigenous plants, educating, advocating, and caring for the bush environment since 1982. The indigenous nursery supplies and offers a great opportunity for gardening with indigenous plants. NES and Knox City Council have been in partnership in co-ordinating the Gardens for Wildlife program.

Lakewood Reserve in Rowville is a fantastic example of the vegetation type that once dominated the Knox landscape. This reserve offers many opportunities for nature lovers, including watching opportunities on the banks of the creek.

Yarabing Wetland is dominated by large reedbeds. Mangroves play an important role for local vegetation, birds, and frogs. Stop for a rest picnic or simply listen to the bush chorus of birds and frogs.

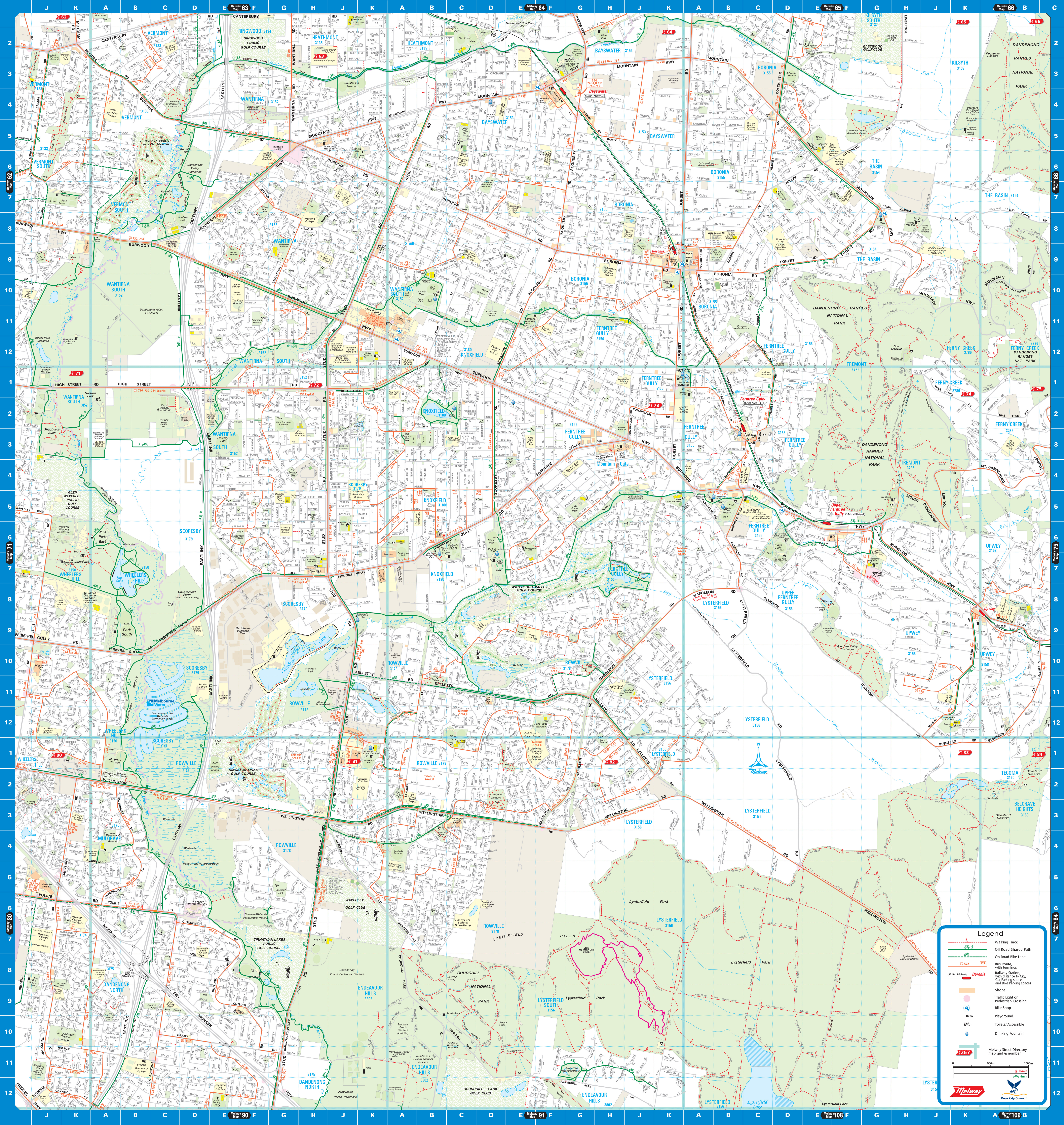
