

Another milestone in the project to determine the future uses of Miller's Homestead has been reached. Read on to hear about what's next and how you can be involved.

The feasibility of options

From the 300 submissions received from the community, Council contracted independent consultants to undertake a feasibility study into the suggestions made.

The feasibility study rated each option using a triple bottom line approach, with the social assessment rated higher than the economic and environmental assessments. The highest rated options were:

- Option 1 Council run events Council delivers programs activities and events for the community to enjoy
- Option 2 Council Services Council delivers services to the community through this building such as children services or community outreach
- Option 3 Combined events, community history and community art space

Community focus groups

Council invited a sample of the community to review the options assessed by the feasibility study and provide detailed feedback on each option.

A number of themes emerged from the focus group discussions:

- Miller's should be accessible to as many groups and people within the community as possible.
- Parking, traffic, noise and hours of use should be considered so that quality of life of the local neighbourhood is not disrupted.
- Any food provision should support community activities, rather than being the primary focus of the Homestead.
- Council must be committed to actively managing the Homestead and activities that take place at the site.

- Collective use options are preferred to maximise use and encourage the most diverse use of Miller's.
