

Glossary

Access Key - A customised accessibility guide that provides accurate and convenient information about accessing venues, events and programs. Access Keys are universally designed and suitable for all people, regardless of ability.

ACTIVE Supervision- Parents must have their children within eyesight at all times when actively supervising.

AFFL - Above finished floor level.

Balance - A biological system that enables us to maintain a body's desired position and requires a number of sensory systems to work together. Good balance builds better posture, helpws to prevent falling over when standing or moving, improves coordination and increases muscular power.

Cardiovascular - Relating to the heart and blood vessels.

Casual Guest - Visitors, non-members.

Changing Places - A facility for people who cannot use standard accessible toilets. They provide extra features and more space to meet the needs of people with disabilities or additional requirements.

ESL - English as a Second Language.

Exercise Physiology - For people with acute, sub-acute, or chronic medical conditions, injuries or disabilities. It involves qualified health professionals delivering and evaluating safe and effective exercise interventions.

Flexibility - The ability of joints to move through a range of motion while unrestricted and pain free.

Gross Motor Skills - Gross motor skills use the large muscles of the body. Commonly used gross motor skills include actions such as rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, riding a bike, and climbing stairs. Gross motor skills are essential to movement and participating in activities at school and at home.

Interpersonal and Social Skills - Relating to relationships or communication between people and the ability to interact with them in the most efficient and proper manner.

HHSH - Hand held shower hose.

Members - A person who has paid for membership to attend and use the facilities.

NDIS - National Disability Insurance Scheme.

Proprioception - awareness of position and movement of the body.

Social Interaction - Consider the perspective of other people and understand their needs.

Sensory Exploration - The stimulation of one's senses: touch, smell, taste, movement, balance, sight and hearing.

Sensory Regulation - Relates to an individual's ability to increase and decrease their alertness, or arousal, to match the situation or environment.

TGSI - Tactile ground surface indicators. A tactile ground surface to assist pedestrians who are visually impaired. Often found on footpaths, stairs and train station platforms.

- Once the visit has taken place, revisit the Access Key to celebrate success.

Aquatic Supervision Rules

- Children under the age of 5 must remain within arm's reach of a parent/guardian at all times in the water.
- Children under the age of 10 will not be allowed entry without a parent/guardian at least 16 years or older and must be ACTIVELY supervised at all times within the centre.
- Parent/guardian are to use their knowledge of the child's swimming ability to determine the level of supervision required for children over the age of 10.



Getting There

Knox Leisureworks Aquatic and Recreation Centre is located at 35 Tormore Road, Boronia.

The nearest bus stop is located approximately 550 metres from the centre at the corner of Tormore/Boronia Roads.

There is a taxi zone directly outside the entrance.

Parking

Parking for Knox Leisureworks Aquatic and Recreation Centre is located at the front of the centre. Enter via Penrith Avenue or Tormore Road.

There is:

- Eight accessible parking bays located between 25 50 metres from the entrance.
- Four parents with pram parking bays approximately 60 metres from the entrance.
- · General parking.

A dedicated drop off point and bus parking are located directly outside the entrance.

Overflow parking is located in the neighbouring streets. No restrictions apply.



Welcome

Welcome to Knox Leisureworks Aquatic and Recreation Centre.

Entry is via two sets of automated glass doors, each with a clearance of 1200mm.

Resources and brochures are also available.


Members

Pool Hall

The Pool Hall is located ahead of reception.

- 1. At reception go through the swing gate or turnstile.
- 2. Enter the Pool Hall via an automated glass sliding door with a clearance of 860mm.
- 3. Follow the 50-metre access ramp down to pool level. This ramp at a 1:14 gradient has 2 landing platforms and 2 turning points.





Toilets

At Knox Leisureworks Aquatic and Recreation Centre there are four sets of toilets.

First Set:

Location: In reception fover, opposite the café.

Includes:

- A unisex, accessible toilet with sensor lighting.
- Manual door opening inward. Door clearance of 860mm. Latch lock 970mm AFFL.
- Cubicle space 2000mm x 3250mm.
- Grab bars to the right and behind toilet.
- Toilet height 450mm AFFL with right hand transfer.
- Sink height 820mm AFFL with lever tap 940mm AFFL.
- Shower with HHSH, grab bars and shower bench.
- Separate male and female toilets, showers and change rooms with ambulant toilets and baby change area in each set.

Second Set:

Location: In the Pool Hall, between the Program Swimming Pool and Spa, at the bottom of the access ramp.

Includes:

- A unisex, accessible toilet with artificial lighting.
- Manual door opening inward. Door clearance of 870mm. Twist lock 1020mm AFFL.
- Cubicle space 2080mm x 3500mm.
- Grab bars to the left.
- Toilet height 450mm AFFL with left hand transfer.
- Sink height 860mm AFFL with lever tap 980mm
- Shower with HHSH, grab bars and shower bench.
- Separate male and female toilets, showers and change rooms with ambulant toilets and baby change area in each.
- Separate family change cubicles.

Third Set:

Location: In the Pool Hall, nearest to the Warm Water Pool.

Includes:

- Eight separate, unisex change cubicles and one unisex toilet.
- Four separate unisex, accessible toilets with artificial lighting.
- Manual door opening inward. Door clearance of 980mm. Twist lock 1100mm AFFL.
- Cubicle space 2100mm x 2670mm.
- Toilet height 450mm AFFL.
- Sink height 790mm AFFL and lever tap 790mm AFFL.
- Shower with HHSH, grab bars and shower bench.
- One unisex accessible toilet with grab bars to the left and behind toilet with left hand transfer.
- Three unisex accessible toilets with grab bars to the right and behind toilet with right hand transfer.

Accessible Toilet with Change Facility

Location: In the Pool Hall, adjacent to the Program Swimming Pool. To use this facility, you will require a key. See staff at reception or at the lifeguard station for assistance. The lifeguard station is located in the Pool Hall between the 50m Lap and Recreation pool and the Toddler pool.

Includes:

- A fully accessible, unisex toilet with artificial lighting.
- Automated door opening inward. Door clearance of 880mm.Automated lock 1170mm AFFL.
- Flip up grab bars on either side of toilet.
- Toilet height 450mm with left- or right-hand transfer and colour contrast toilet seat.
- Sink height 890mm AFFL with lever tap 960mm AFFL.
- Shower HHSH, grab bars and shower bench.
- Guldmann GH3+3 hoist with maximum weight capacity of 250kg.
- The maximum weight of the adult change table is 150kg.

Please remember to bring your own sling and ensure it is compatible with the hoist. If there is any uncertainty, please do not use hoist.

Indoor Warm Water Pool

The Warm Water Pool is located in the far-right corner of the Pool Hall.


It is utilised for gentle exercise which is optimal for recovery and relaxation. It can also be used for group fitness classes. During this time, it will be closed to the public.

Includes:

- Access ramp, with handrails, approximately
 10 metres in length at a 1:14 gradient.
- Pelican pool hoist with maximum weight capacity of 200kg. See staff for assistance.
- Temperature approximately 34 degrees celsius.
- Maximum depth 1.6 metres.
- Handrail around the interior perimeter.

Our group fitness timetable is available <u>online</u> or call us on (03) 9762 3133 to check if the pool is available prior to attending.

Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to use this pool without medical clearance and must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Indoor 50m Lap & Recreation Pool


The 50m Lap and Recreation Pool is located in the centre of the Pool Hall.

It is utilised for lap swimming, swimming lessons, alternative group training, pool games and casual swimming.

Includes:

- Access ramp, with handrails, approximately, 20 metres in length at a 1:14 gradient.
- Steps with handrails.
- If required, a person can be lifted into a water wheelchair via the hoist located at the indoor Warm Water Pool. See staff for assistance.
- Temperature approximately 28 degrees celsius.
- Depth 1 to 1.8 metres.

Includes:

- Steps with handrails.
- Temperature approximately 32 degrees celsius.
- Maximum depth 1 metre.

Indoor Toddler Pool


The Indoor Toddler Pool is located at the bottom of the Pool Hall access ramp.

It is utilised for swimming lessons, pool games and casual swimming.

Includes:

- · Beach entry.
- Temperature approximately 32 degrees celsius.
- Maximum depth 1 metre.
- Mini water-slide. Step entry with handrails.
- Variety of water features that sprinkle rain and spray water.

Terms and conditions of use are clearly signed.

Spa

The Spa is located at the bottom of the Pool Hall access ramp, opposite the Toddler Pool.

Includes:

- Step entry with handrails. There are three steps up to reach the spa and then five steps down into the water.
- Temperature approximately 37 degrees celsius.
- Maximum depth 0.9 metres.
- Push button operated water and air jets.
 Buttons located left of spa entrance steps.

For enjoyment of the spa, please:

- Limit spa use to a maximum of 15 minutes at one time.
- Bring a water bottle to stay well hydrated.
- Do not use the spa if you are pregnant.
- Do not exercise in the spa.
- Do not put your head under water.

Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to use the spa at any time.

If you are taking medication or are unwell, please seek medical advice before using the spa.

Our gym equipment includes:


- Cardio Equipment.

- Staff can provide assistance to visitors wishing to use a wheelchair to access Pool Hall.
- Chairs with backrests and couches located in reception foyer.

- Café located in reception foyer. Café counter height 900mm.
- · Large print menu at café.
- Café tables 700mm high x 370mm deep.
- Clear spaces between furniture for a person to manoeuvre a mobility aid.
- Guardrail at Pool Hall viewing platform 1100mm AFFL.
- Additional tables within Pool Hall at top of access ramp and next to Toddler Pool. Table heights 710mm x 325mm deep.
- Chairs with backrests and bench seating throughout Pool Hall.
- Chairs with backs and armrests near Warm Water pool.
- Motorised scooter permitted in Pool Hall. Restrictions apply.
- Pram and mobility scooter parking at pool side.
- Five aquatic wheelchairs. See staff for assistance.



- Exit from centre is via a swing gate with a clearance of 1200mm followed by two automated doors. Note, short seven second closing time delay on swing gate.
- Visible and illuminated exit signs.
- ReadSpeak facility available <u>online</u> providing audio message about services and facilities.

Safety

- ACTIVE Supervision: Parents must have their children within eyesight at all times when actively supervising.

- No TGSI prior to waterslide entry steps.
- No TGSI prior to spa entry steps.
- Drainage grate surrounding Toddler Pool.
- Walking only in Pool Hall.
- Motorised scooter permitted in Pool Hall.
- Gym entry door with contrast decals at 1000mm to 1100mm AFFL.
- Contrast band 1000mm to 1060mm AFFL on gym windows.
- Please visit our website to view our 24/7 gym safety measures.
- Contrast decals at 1030mm to 1130mm AFFL on group fitness room access door.
- Contrast decals at 1070mm to 1130mm AFFL on creche access door.
- Duress alarm located within accessible changeroom.

- If first aid is required, please see staff.
- A defibrillator is located in the gym and on pool deck first aid room.
- In the event of an emergency, staff will help and direct members and visitors. If there is to be an evacuation, members and visitors will be directed to the nearest exit and designated assembly area.
- Evacuation maps are located throughout the facility.
