Noticeboard: In response to COVID-19 and public safety we present to you a revised Outings program.

The new Outings will be 3 – 4 hours only with less travel time and less passengers but more often.

There are 2 categories of Outing. One for relaxing, socializing and a brunch stop only, called **Social Sorties**. The second for the more active participants, called **Activeons** which are BYO only. You can enjoy both if you wish.

Routine pick up locations, times and Priority of Access seat allocation will continue.

For the safety of all, before entry you will be required to answer COVID-19 questions, sanitize, wear a mask and socially distance.

- The cost of the bus is \$8.70 per person. This will be billed to you after your travel.
- If you are unable to attend an outing, we require a minimum of 24 hours' notice, otherwise you will be charged for the trip.
- Note, lunch prices can vary and venues may need to change without notice.
