Ticket Sales

Refunds

The ticket is sold or issued by Knox City Council and is subject to Australian Consumer Law and to the following conditions.

- 1. The ticket is non-refundable and not available for exchange, unless required by Australian Consumer Law or subject to condition 2.
- 2. The ticket can be refunded, if you are unable to attend as you have COVID symptoms or are in isolation.
- 3. The right is reserved to vary the advertised program and audience capacity.
- 4. The right of admission is reserved by the venue and/or its' agent. Cameras, tape recorders and other recording devices are not permitted.
- 5. If an activity is cancelled due to an Act of God, natural disaster, adverse weather or for any other cause reasonably beyond the agent's control, there is no right of refund or exchange, and no obligation is assured by Knox City Council for the arranging of a substitute service, event or performance.

Conditions of Entry

Arrival

All patrons must pre-register their attendance by purchasing a ticket.
