

- Knox Waste trucks empty approximately
   5.8 million bins per year
- Approximately 29,500 tonnes of waste went to landfill last year
- 41% of the average Knox waste bin contains food waste

- On average, 13% of Knox's recycling is contaminated with items that do not belong in the recycling bin
- Each week we collect an average of 9.4kg of general waste and 4.6kg of recycling per Knox household



Knox residents are excellent recyclers but there are even more steps you can take to reduce waste:



# Decrease your waste



### Waste garbage bin - emptied weekly.

Garbage collection will occur on your allocated day, including public holidays.



### These items can go into your waste garbage bin



Household garbage



Nappies (wrapped), tissues and paper towel



Polystyrene and coffee cups



Plastic packages, wrappers, food packaging and cling film (or REDcycle at supermarkets)



Window glass, mirrors, Pyrex, ceramics and drinking glasses (wrapped)



Food waste, bones and meat, fish and poultry scraps (bagged)



These items cannot go into your waste garbage bin



No Green waste



No E-waste



No Recyclable products



No Liquids including motor oil, pesticides, paints or solvents



No Syringes, batteries, chemicals or other hazardous waste



No Timber, bricks, rubble, steel, building materials or hot ashes

### Our goal is to help reduce household waste going to landfill



- Recycling is not limited to our kerbside recycling bin - How can you reduce your garbage going into landfill?
   Visit knox.vic.gov.au/reducewaste
- E-Waste is any item with a plug, battery or power cord. E-Waste cannot go in your garbage bin. It can be recycled as part of hard waste or you can take it to the Knox Transfer Station and Recycling Facility.
- You can save money and reduce your garbage going to landfill by swapping your 120 litre bin for an 80 litre bin. Contact Knox City Council to make the swap.
- Don't overfill or place rubbish beside your bin
- · Keep bin lid closed at kerbside
- · Maximum weight is 50kg



### Recycle bin - emptied fortnightly.

Collection will occur on your allocated day, alternating with green waste.



### These items can go into your recycle bin



Empty milk and juice cartons



Empty glass bottles and jars



Empty plastic containers and pots



Cardboard packaging, egg cartons and clean pizza boxes (no food)



Empty cans/aerosols (steel/ aluminium). Clean aluminium foil, pie trays, metal pots & pans (no glass lids)



Papers, envelopes, junk mail, flyers, brochures, newspapers, magazines & telephone books

# These items cannot go into your recycle bin



No Nappies



No E-waste



No Green waste



No Tissues, garbage, bagged recycling, polystyrene or coffee cups



**No** Syringes, batteries, chemicals, hazardous waste or aerosols (unless empty).



No Bricks, rocks, concrete, soil, rubble or timber



No Clothes, linen or shoes



No Crockery, pyrex, light globes, mirrors, broken glass or drinking glasses (as they will not melt at the glass refinery)



No Waxed cardboard, plastic bags, cling film or wrappings (including those labelled as recyclable, compostable or biodegradable)

### Our goal is to help reduce recycling going to landfill



- Always empty bottles and containers before adding to recycling bin
- All recycled items should be loose
- No plastic bags or soft plastics
- Max weight 50kg

- Soft plastics that can be scrunched into a ball, can be taken to a REDcycle drop off bin. Visit redycle.net.au/what-to-redcycle to find out what you can keep out of landfill and where you can take it.

### These items cannot go into your garden waste bin or bundled collection



No Household rubbish, food, syringes or pet faeces



No Bagged green waste in any type of bag including collapsible style or stand-up bag



No Logs, stumps or tree limbs larger than 10cm in diameter or longer than 30cm



No Plant pots, wire, bricks, rocks, rubble or timber



No Soil or potting mix including soil attached to garden waste



No E-waste

### You have several options for your green waste service.



# Mobile green waste bin supplied by Council (red lid)

 This service is an optional user pays service
 This bin is the only mobile bin that will be emptied as part of the green waste service. Max. weight 50kg



#### **Bundled collection**

- Bundled branches up to 30cm in diameter and 1.5m in length tied with natural string/twine. Maximum weight 30kg
- Multiple bundles are permitted



#### Own container

- Plastic or galvanized bin (max. volume of 55L and weight of 30kg) or rigid box of similar size
- Containers will be returned to nature strip after collection
- Privately owned containers are the owner's responsibility



Our goal is to help reduce green waste going to landfill

- All green waste collected by Council is processed into compost material
- Keeping green waste loose and not squashed down in the bin makes it easier to transfer to the truck
- Keep the lid closed to keep pests out
- Plastic bags contaminate compost produced and should **never** be put in green waste
- In 2023 we will be introducing a new food and garden waste service



# **Hard waste service** - available twice per financial year. Collection must be booked online or through our Customer Service

### These items can go out for your hard waste collection



Household furniture



Carpet rolled (max 1.5m) (limit two rolls)



Metal tools/equipment



Household appliances (fridge doors removed)



Iron, metals, old empty tins with lids removed



Mattresses or bed bases (limit two)



Timber (max 10 pieces) and tree stumps. Max length 1.5m and 30kg



Crockery and kitchenware items securely wrapped if prone to breakage



Sheet glass securely wrapped and labelled for safety



E-waste items with a plug, battery or power cord

Please note that your hard waste will be collected between Monday and Friday of the week booked.

### These items cannot go out for your hard waste collection



No Building, demolition or renovation material including asbestos, gyprock, and cement sheeting



No Syringes, batteries, liquids, chemical or hazardous waste



No Soil or green waste except tree stumps (Max length 1.5m and 30kg)



No Gas bottles, fuel containers or oil



No Gates, fencing, trellis or pallets



No Tyres or car parts of any kind



No Tiles, bricks and concrete



No Household garbage, recyclables or food waste



No Commercial waste

### Important hard waste notes

- All items must be out by 6am on the Monday of collection week
- Bookings must be made prior to placement of hard waste
- Place items out no more than 2 days prior to collection week
- Place items in a neat pile and put smaller items out in non-returnable boxes

- If items are not out in time for collection, the booking will be forfeited
- Missed collections must be reported within one week of the allocated collection week
- Eligible households are entitled to two collections per financial year
- For collection size limits go to knox.vic.gov.au/hardrubbish

#### It is illegal to:

- Put items out without a prior booking
- Dump waste
- Scavenge items for commercial gain
- · Add to a neighbour's pile

Fines will apply under Council's Local Laws

### **Bin Placement Requirements -**

To assist in providing a safe and efficient service, please consider the placement of your bins for collection

#### Bin spacing



- Ensure bins are at least 50cm apart
- Place bins with wheels and handles facing away from the kerb




 Allow a minimum of 1 metre clearance from parked cars, trees, light poles or any other obstructions



 Ensure bin lids are closed when presented for collection

#### Hammerhead and court bowls







- Collection of bins in dead-end streets can be difficult for trucks
- Place bins in the straight section of the street

#### **Time**

- Put bins out before 6.00am on collection day
- Return bins to your property within 24 hours
- Missed collections must be reported within 1.5 days of collection day
- Bins will be collected on all Public Holidays




