PLEASE NOTE:

- **Feedback forms will be forwarded by Council to neighbouring properties that may be affected by this application to seek comment on your application.**
- **A property inspection by an Authorised Officer will be required prior to your permit being finalised.**
- **Permits are renewed annually.**

CONDITIONS:

- All dogs and cats over 3 months of age must be registered with the Knox City Council and securely confined to your premises in accordance with the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*.
- If a permit is granted, it will be subject to review following receipt of any complaints from neighbouring properties, and is valid for 1 (one) year from date of issue/renewal.
- Any animal housing, runs, yards, sheds, pens, kennels, etc, constructed on the property will need to be kept in a sanitary condition, and are subject to the requirements of the Knox City Council Amenity Local Law 2020 and any relevant codes of practice.
- Failure to comply with any permit conditions could result in the permit being cancelled and/or penalties as prescribed in the Local Law.
- A Community Laws officer will attend and inspect the animals, and housing of the animals to ensure that the animals are kept in accordance with the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1986*, with adequate shelter, food and water, and secured to the property in a manner to maintain safety of the animals and prevent nuisance to any neighbouring residents.
- Any excess excrement is disposed of in a manner to prevent odour, and in accordance with the Public Health and Wellbeing Act 2008.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

DEFINITIONS

- Livestock** An animal of any species used in connection with primary production or kept for recreational purposes other than a dog or a cat (includes but is not limited to horses, cattle, sheep, donkeys, mules, goats, pigs and deer of any age).
- Rodent** Includes any rabbits, guinea pigs, mice, rats and hamsters and other mammals characterized by incisors adapted for gnawing and nibbling.
- Poultry** Includes any chickens, ducks, geese, peacocks, pheasants, turkeys, bantam, squab, guinea fowls and anything similar of any age excluding roosters.
- Large Bird** Any cockatoo or other bird of similar or larger size of any age but does not include poultry or pigeons.
- Small Bird** Any budgerigar, canary, finch or other similar size or smaller bird (excluding poultry).
