

# Instrument of Delegation – Child Link User (Child Wellbeing and Safety Act)



**By this Instrument of Delegation, in exercise of the power conferred by s 46L of the *Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005* (Act) I, as the Chief Executive Officer of Knox City Council:**
