



**Stage 1 - Inner Commercial Area – Shopping Centre and Station precinct** 





### **Bayswater Parking Management Plan**

### **Proposed Timeline**

The following timeline collates the actions identified as part of the investigation and consultation process for the development of the Bayswater Parking Management Plan and indicates the approximate time frames for the projects.

Action involving changes to parking restrictions on public roads can be managed by Council and completed within a 3-month period while actions involving advocacy are generally outside Council's jurisdiction.

June 2024

Council to endorse Parking Management Plan

June - Aug 2024

- Implement parking restriction changes in the Commercial Area
- Implement 'no parking' restriction changes in King St for safe access
- Ensure existing signage is compliant

July 2024 - Jun 2025

- Review Bayswater business permit allocation
- Install a new accessible space (dependent on suitable location) in:
- James St/ Valentine St carpark
- •Mountain Hwy (north side between Church St and Valentine St)
- •Pine Road Carpark

Ongoing advocacy

- Advocate with PTV for improved public transport and some 4 hour parking within station car park
- Advocate with private owners for Australian Standard signage in their carparks within the commercial area
- Advocate for further EV and car share spaces within activity centre
- Public education about active transport

Ongoing

- Implement parking restrictions in residential area as requested or needed
- Install inground sensors in some short term parking spaces in conjunction with Community Laws.
- Work with Community Laws regarding business permits for eligible businesses
- Work with Community Laws to ensure enforcement of parking restrictions
