2025-26 Application to Register as a Foster Carer

A foster carer is a person who undertakes temporary care of an individual or special group of animals for the purpose of giving the animals care until they can be rehomed.

Provisions of the Domestic Animals Amendment (Puppy Farm and Pet Shops) Act 2017 introduces a voluntary initiative where foster carers may register with their local council under a foster carer scheme.

Those individuals that choose to register as a foster carer are entitled to a reduced registration rate for the animals in their care, along with access to pet shops to rehome their dogs over six months of age, and cats over eight weeks of age. The reduced rate for animals in foster care will save foster carers money for the first 12 months that the animal is in their care.

- Every dog and cat over 3 months old must be registered with the Council in which they are located.
- Every dog and cat must be microchipped to be registered with Council.
- Every dog and cat must wear their Council registration tag when outside the property in which they are kept.
- Dogs must be adequately confined to the house/yard and must not be allowed to stray.
- Dogs and cats must not be allowed to cause nuisance (i.e. excess barking).
- Owners of dogs and cats must be over 18 years old.

Knox City Council Amenity Local Law 2020 states a permit is required to keep more than 2 cats or 2 dogs.

The Domestic Animals Amendment (Puppy Farm and Pet Shops) Act 2017 limits foster care to a maximum of five dogs or cats (with a litter under 16 weeks of age counting as a single animal) per premises. This does not include permanent pets owned by the foster carer that are registered with council.

- Permit application to Keep Additional Animals if a permit is not currently in place and the total number of animals to be kept at your property is more than 2 cats or more than 2 dogs. (Please note that the accumulated total of cats and dogs that can be kept on your property can not exceed five (5) unless a planning permit issued under the provisions of the Knox Planning Scheme allows a greater number
