The Immerse month-long festival takes art out of galleries and into public spaces through guided bus tours. These trips showcase interactive works, performances, projections and other creative surprises along the way.

Immerse shows how public art can bring people together, spark imagination and create shared experiences. Its unique, bus-based approach makes each year memorable and inspiring.

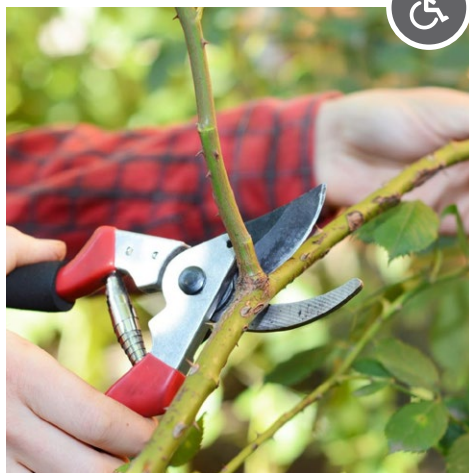
